## CASP FEBRUARY 2012 VACATION PROGRAM

**for a daily minimum of 15 children and a maximum of 50**

CASP is offering a four day vacation program (see above dates) that is offered to a limited number of students. We reduce our daily numbers as our teaching staff is reduced in half as we are required to only work one of the vacation weeks and the custodial staff needs to clean the building during the school population's week off.

We will be venturing out on Wednesday through Friday on field trips, without a half day or stay back option. **Cost of this program is \$60.00 per day, plus an additional "activity and transportation fee" of \$20-\$25 per day.** Transportation is being provided by Local Motion of Boston, and seatbelts have been requested. Please do not include payment with your application as you will be billed for the dates requested on your March invoice. As this invoice does come out in advance of the vacation program you will be responsible for the daily fee and any of the prepaid activities if your child is absent for any reason. If we have a waiting list we will try to fill your space. If the space is filled you will be given a full refund for the day.

Morning and afternoon snack along with a lunch will be provided daily. Students will make their own lunch at CASP on Tuesday and will make a bag lunch for Thursday's trip to The EcoTarium before we leave. Children with dietary needs or food allergies should speak with Lee prior to the vacation. A lunch from home is optional for children who do not care for our menu selection.

The February vacation staff includes Amanda Gray, Lee Guertin, Zack Hardy, Maida Ives, Carly Johanson, Jenn Lewis, Audrey Stephenson, Moe Sullivan and Hester Breen. During the vacation week we will be using the lunch rooms and the gym. We ask that you and your child(ren) enter the building through main lobby doors. Baskets will be lined up in the hallway for belongings and all participants must be signed in by a parent or a legal guardian. **Please do not drop your child off without coming in to the building to sign them in.** If your child is absent on a day they are scheduled to attend the program please notify us in the morning. **CASP is requesting that families only communication with us during the vacation week by phone as we might not have time to check email that week.**
